Due to Covid-19 all of our major fund raising for 2020 has had to be cancelled so we are looking for alternative ways of raising money for charity. For this event we are looking to support two organisations that require additional support in the current circumstances. This event allows you to play any course at any time until Sunday 16th September and then email your scorecard to us by 19th September at latest, ideally within 3 days of the round. The entry cost is only £5 per person, ie £15/team

Details

Prizes for the top 4 teams. Team prizes as follows

- 1st - 10% of all entry fees collected
- 2nd - 7.5% of all entry fees collected
- 3rd - 5% of all entry fees collected
- 4th - 2.5% of all entry fees collected

To meet Covid-19 restrictions at launch of the event, it will be teams of 3 people in any combination of men and ladies. 80% of handicap, with a maximum of 24 for men and 36 for ladies. Men to play off yellow tees, ladies from ladies tee.

Stableford format with two scores to count on holes 1-9 and all 3 to count on holes 10-18.

To enter email allanderrotary@outlook.com with your team name, the course you will be playing, date you plan to play \pm 3 days, names and handicaps of team members and club they are a member of plus a contact phone number. We will then send you details of how to pay your entry fee, that must be paid ahead of playing your round. It will be permissible to amend your team if notified ahead of your round being played.
